

MOSSMAN AND DISTRICT SHOW SOCIETY INC.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. This show is held under the Rules and Regulations of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies and the Rules and By-Laws of the Mossman and District Show Society Inc.
2. Although the substance of some of the Rules of the Society are set out here under, for emphasis and general direction, this Statement of Conditions shall not be deemed to be an exhaustive statement of the Rules and By-Laws of the Society, all of which shall be in full force and application.
3. For particulars of Entry Fees, closing dates of entries, dates and times for delivery of exhibits and special conditions relative to the particular Sections, see the head notes to the individual Sections appearing in the schedules. Intending exhibitors are advised to read the Schedules carefully and to be sure to enter exhibits in the correct Classes.
4. **MEMBERSHIP SUBSCRIPTION FAMILY** tickets of \$45.00 carries the privilege of two adult tickets, plus a ticket for each of the Member's dependent children. Each ticket will admit the bearer to the Show throughout the whole period thereof (both Sunday and Monday) as often as desired. Tickets must be produced otherwise ordinary admission will be charged.
ADULT SINGLE tickets of \$25.00 are available to adults over 18 years of age. **CHILD SINGLE** tickets of \$10.00 are available to all school aged children. Such tickets will entitle admission to the grounds as above but no entitlement as Members of the Society.
PENSIONER (2) tickets are available for \$25.00. **PENSIONER SINGLE** tickets are available for \$15.00 Entrance to the grounds for **NON – MEMBERSHIP TICKET HOLDERS** will be charged at the **DAILY RATE**: Adults: \$20.00, Children: \$8.00 (Children under school age are admitted free). **Pensioners**: \$10.00 (Pensioners must present evidence of entitlement).
5. The Committee shall have full control of all personnel on the grounds, & through its Stewards & other Officials, the conduct & management of the Show.
6. Persons admitted or claiming to be admitted to the grounds shall be subject to the Regulations of the Committee; & the Committee reserves the right by its Executive Officers, Stewards, or other Officials or nominees to:
 - (a) Refuse to admit to the grounds or;
 - (b) Expel and remove from the grounds any person or persons whose conduct (past or present) is, in the opinion of such Committee, Executive Officer's, Stewards or other Officials or nominees, such as to warrant such action.
7. Entries in the show must be made on the Entry Forms provided by the Society and must be in the hands of the Secretary by the stipulated date thereof, together with the Entry Fees without which no Entry will be accepted. Exceptions to this Rule will however, be made in such Sections (in particular the Horticulture, Agriculture and Culinary Sections) where the Stewards thereof on their discretion permit, having reference in particular to time available for completion of Section Books and preparation for Judging. Exceptions will also be made in the case of the Ring Events where (with the exception of 'Local' events) entries will be accepted up to such time as the Stewards, in their absolute discretion, deem fit.
8. In all Sections, it is a condition of entry that the Society will not under any circumstances, be held responsible for any loss, damage, or misdelivery of any livestock or other exhibit or exhibits at the Society's Show, or for any accident that may be caused through, or by, any exhibit. The arrangement of exhibits will be in the sole control of the Stewards. Exhibits entered in the wrong Class by the Exhibitor may be transferred to the proper Class by the Stewards.
9. The Judges may award Certificates of Commendation in addition to awards mentioned in the Schedule, or may withhold any Prize if, in their opinion, the exhibit is not of sufficient merit.
10. The decision of the Judge or Judges shall be final.
11. The Committee reserves the right to substitute trophies donated after printing of Schedules.
12. Supplementary Schedules may be issued at the discretion of the Committee.

13. At all times, from the commencement of delivery of exhibits until the opening of the Hall for general exhibition, the Hall shall be under the control of the stewards therein, who shall have full power to refuse admittance, or cause expulsion from the Hall, of any person or persons other than those who, in the opinion of the Stewards have lawful occasion to be in such Hall.
14. The Committee reserves the right to reduce Prize money for any event, or to cancel the event, if in the opinion of the Committee paucity of entries and/or competitors for such an event does not warrant the amount of Prize Money awarded.
15. The Committee may refuse any entry without giving reasons for so doing.
16. Any person entering a protest in connection with the Show shall lodge the sum of \$20.00 with the Secretary. The onus of proof shall be with the Lodger of the protest. The Committee shall decide all protests and their decision shall be final. If in the opinion of the Committee the protest may be frivolous the deposit shall be forfeited. In the hearing of all protests and disputes arising out of an award, the Committee shall abide by the Judges books unless it is shown that the Judge has been wilfully or accidentally mislead. Protests must be in writing and must be lodged with the Secretary before the day of judging. A protest in any particular class may only be made by a competitor in that class.
17. No exhibit may be removed before 7.00pm on the Monday of the Show without the permission of the Section Stewards.
18. The Rules and By-Laws first above mentioned and the foregoing Statement of Conditions and the notes set forth in the Schedule hereafter appearing, are to be the conditions of the Show and of competition herein. The Committee, whose decision shall be final, shall determine any matter arising, not herein provided for.
19. **ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES:** The attention of intending exhibitors is drawn to the fact that entries are accepted subject to the Rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies and to the Constitution and Rules of this Society in addition to any special regulations which appear within this Schedule.

1. All animals will be shampooed and or cleaned, rinsed and allowed to dry, and their hooves/legs/feet will have been picked clean of all solid material and washed with shampoo.
2. All vehicles and equipment accompanying the animals will be cleaned to remove all solid material that could contain disease agents, and then disinfected.

5. I acknowledge that in failure to comply, I may be directed to leave and my nominations will be forfeited.
6. I acknowledge that decontamination and disinfection procedures may be required of me if instructed by the Event Organising Committee/Manager.
7. All animals described above are free of cattle ticks before entering the event.
8. I acknowledge that the animals above are from a JOHNE'S DISEASE FREE herd/flock.
9. I acknowledge the above mentioned animals to the best of my knowledge are free from any other notifiable diseases. 10. I acknowledge that there is a possibility that animals might become infected with disease agents as a result of any movements and if necessary animals and premises will be placed on a restricted list in accordance with any legislation covering such occurrences including policies and procedures in effect at that time. I agree and acknowledge that the Manager/Event Organising Committee, it's State or National Affiliated bodies and their members are not in any way liable for any cost, expense, loss, damage, claim, action, proceeding or other liability incurred by or made against me as a result of any movement of animals to the Event/Farm.

RING EVENTS

CARD SYSTEM

All Nominations to be completed online before closing date at www.nominate.com.au. You then follow the links to AG.Shows – Mossman Show.

1. All horses competing in Open Jumping Events may be ridden by any rider nominated by the owner.
2. Any horse ridden in a Junior Event may also compete in Graded Events.
3. Any horse may compete in no more than 3 jumping events for the day.
4. All Jumping Events will be judged under F.E.I Rules.
5. In all 'Maiden' Competitions, horses must be Maidens at the time of competing, NOT at the time of entering. Definition of 'Maiden' shall be an animal which, up to time of starting, has never won a First Prize in a similar class.
6. Each horse may be nominated in one owner's name only throughout the programme, as Prize Money will be paid to one person only. The rider's share of the Prize Money is a matter for settlement between the owner and rider. Where possible state the rider's name against each entry.
7. The Stewards reserve the right to add, substitute, alter or delete any Event or Condition, at their own discretion, and also to refuse or cancel any entry without being obliged to give reasons for doing so. All entries will be deemed to have been made out and received subject to these Conditions and to the Rules of the Mossman and District Show Society Inc. The decision of the committee will be final on all points, without recourse.
8. All Competitors entering and competing in these or any other events, do so at their own risk. The Society accepts no responsibility and receives the entries only under these conditions.
9. All Competitors must report to the assembly area immediately when instructed to do so by the Call Steward. As some events will be run concurrently, Competitors in these events must hold themselves within call.
10. No refund of Entry Fees shall be made after closing of entries.
11. When requested by the Stewards, a Competitor in Age Group Events must produce a Birth Certificate as proof of Date of Birth.
12. All Ponies and Galloways must be presented for measuring prior to the nominated event.
13. THE STEWARDS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO OMIT 4TH PLACE, INCLUDING PRIZE MONEY, WHERE THERE ARE LESS THAN 6 HORSES IN ANY EVENT.
14. A final winner must be determined in all events.
15. **EVERYONE IS REQUIRED TO PURCHASE EITHER A 1 –DAY OR 2- DAY ENTRY TICKET. (See front of Schedule for details). THIS ENTITLES THEM TO FREE CAMPING FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW. Everyone will be issued with wrist bands to indicate payment of entry fees. Wrist bands are to be worn at all times.**

Novice: Shall mean that the entry has never won a Championship in a similar event at the time of starting.

Local: Determined as a resident of the Former Douglas Shire or a resident of Julatten and Mt Molloy areas.




